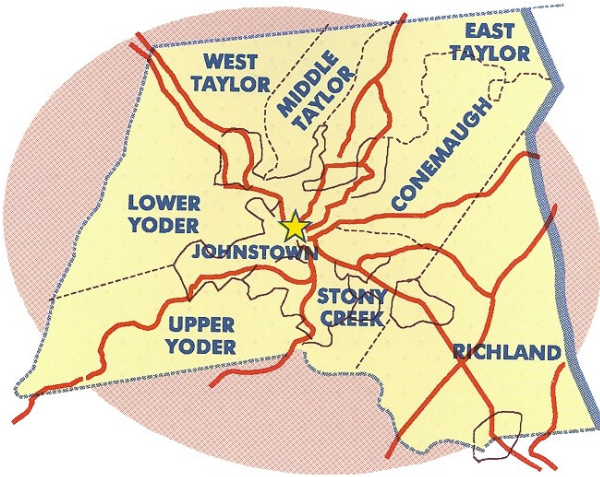

## PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

PwD is a bus program that you can ride to work, shopping, visiting or to any of your appointments in accordance with daily schedules.

For best service, call us before you schedule your appointments—we'll tell you the best time to schedule.

All buses in our system are wheelchair-accessible.

PwD is available for those with disabilities aged 18 to 64 years old.

Call or stop by our office today to see if you are eligible. You will receive an application that will be used to determine eligibility as well as complete program information.

This program is considered a payer of last resort, which means that if you already receive some kind of funding for transportation such as medical trip assistance those trips are not eligible through the PwD. If you have some transportation funded, you may still be eligible for PwD to fund other types of trips.

**Transportation not available:  
New Years Day, Memorial Day,  
Independence Day, Labor Day,  
Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.  
Service may be limited or  
suspended during inclement weather.**

## RATES

The PwD Program is only for persons with disabilities between the ages of 18-64. Funding for this service only pays for a portion of the trip, the passenger must pay a \$3.00 fare regardless of where the origin or destination of the trip is within our Reserve-A-Ride/Shared Ride Service Area.

**Certain restrictions apply based on seating available and trip eligibility. Fares subject to change. Ask our customer service representative for fare information when you make your reservation.**



The PwD Service is subsidized by the Pennsylvania Rural Transportation Program for Persons with Disabilities.

## CANCELLATIONS

Passengers who wish to cancel a scheduled ride, must notify CamTran+ before 8:00 am for same day cancellations. All ride terminations that take place after the time designated in the cancellation policy will be considered a no-show. Cancellations and all ride terminations must be made before the bus leaves the garage. Contact our office for the full policy.

## SCHEDULE

PwD operates in different areas of the community Monday through Friday. Check below to see which day PwD is in your neighborhood.

**Monday**—Richland, Scalp Level, Stoney Creek, Westmont, Southmont, Lower Yoder and Brownstown

**Tuesday**—Johnstown, Middle Taylor, West Taylor and Dale

**Wednesday**—Upper Yoder, Ferndale, Lorain, Geistown, Richland, Scalp Level and Stoney Creek

**Thursday**—Westmont, Southmont, Lower Yoder, Brownstown, Geistown, Ferndale, Lorain and Upper Yoder

**Friday**—Richland, Scalp Level, Stoney Creek, Conemaugh, Franklin, East Taylor, East Conemaugh and Daisytown

## HOW TO RIDE

Call by 2:00 p.m. the day before to schedule your ride.

We provide door-to-door service to all who need transportation within Cambria County, and who are more than 1/4 of a mile from a fixed bus route.

Also it can be used by people who are unable to get to a regular bus stop.

Call to schedule your trip. You will be given a pick-up time. Please be ready ten minutes before your scheduled pick-up time.
