CamTran Service is Cancelled for Fixed Route, ADA and Reserve-A-Ride (Shared Ride) Service on Sunday January 25, 2026, Due to the Impending Winter Storm and Expected Dangerous Weather Conditions

Johnstown, PA (January 23, 2026) – Due to Winter Storm Fern and in the interest of safety for both customers and employees, CamTran is advising riders that there will be no bus service on Sunday January 25, 2026. Forecasts are predicting snowfall at rates as high as 2” per hour with total accumulations ranging between 12”-18” of snowfall.

No fixed route, ADA paratransit, or shared ride services will operate throughout the day on Sunday. This decision has been made proactively in response to expected hazardous winter weather conditions that could impact safe transit operations.

However, due to the severity of the winter storm forecasted on Sunday, bus service has been cancelled for the safety of our riders, bus operators and maintenance employees.
